AWARDS, FACTS, HIGHLIGHTS, AND HONORS

Ranked 9th in the State Poll for the third consecutive year.

Drew 7200 fans against Bradenton-Manatee to establish a home attendance record.

Defeated the Nashville, Tennessee, City Champions-Father Ryan (6-2-2) by the score of 26-19 in a post season game in Fort Myers.

Orville Howell (T) 1st Team All-Conference
and was selected to play in the F.H.S.A.A. North- South All-Star Game

Ray Creel (T) 2nd Team All-Conference
Charles Watson (E) 2nd Team All-Conference

Olin Renfroe (FB) 1st Team All-Conference and Captain, **1st Team All-State, Honorable Mention All-South**. Olin became the 4th Renfroe brother to lead his team in scoring and rushing his senior year and make 1st Team All-Conference. His 17 TDS were the 3rd highest single season total behind, brother Joe (26) and brother J.R. (18).

The following is a list of records established by Olin Renfroe:

Total yards in a game (247 vs Arcadia) and (242 vs Father Ryan)
Most yards rushing in a season (1192)
100 yards rushing games in a season (8)
100 yards rushing games in a career (14)
Most consecutive 100 yard rushing games (7)

His 1192 yards rushing in 1952 stood up until Taylor Timmons' 1362 in 1975, 23 years later.

He became the 7th Greenie to lead his team in rushing and passing in the same season

He returned 4 punts for touchdowns in 1952 which set the school record for punt return touchdowns in a season and his total of 4 return touchdowns in a season tied the same amount as Jimmie Randall in 1936.

For the season, Olin scored 17 out of 26 Greenie Touchdowns, .653% second highest percentage behind behind brother Joe's .684 in 1940.

Olin Renfroe was voted Outstanding Greenie.
